PUMPKIN RING TOSS

Items needed:

Pumpkins with long stems
Rings for ring toss game

Instructions:

Choose two players for this game. Each player gets 3-5 chances to toss rings at the pumpkins. They score a point for each pumpkin they successfully “ring” around the stem. The person with the most points wins a prize.

Variation:

You can make the pumpkins worth different amounts of points to add more challenge and fun to the game.

What's the Point?

Get your ring around a pumpkin stem, and you win. We are winners in God's eyes when we go where we are needed to meet the needs of people around us.

MINI-PUMPKIN TOSS

Items needed:

Two mini-pumpkins

Instructions:

Pick two teams of two. Have the kids stand face-to-face, three feet apart. Give one pumpkin to a member of each team. Have that team member toss the pumpkin to their partner. If their partner catches it, have them take a step backwards and toss the pumpkin back. Keep stepping back and tossing the pumpkin until one team drops their pumpkin. The other team is the winner.

Variation:

More than two teams, if desired, can play this game.

What's the Point?

God wants us to look out for and take care of those around us who need help. Just like you tried to take care of and protect the mini-pumpkins in this game.

MINI-PUMPKIN BOWLING

Items needed:

Mini-pumpkins

Empty plastic milk chugs

Instructions:

Set up six milk chugs like bowling pins on stage. Choose three players for this game. Each player will get three rolls to try and knock down all the milk chugs. Any player who can get all six wins a prize. If no one knocks all six down, the kid who gets the most knocked over wins.

Variation:

If time is short, give each contestant only one roll. You can also use empty soda bottles or cans for this game.

What's the Point?

With God's help, anyone, even kids, can do big things!

CANDY DROPS

Items needed:

Two chairs

Two Halloween pumpkin candy buckets

Two bags of the peanut butter candy in the orange and black wrappers

Instructions:

Set the candy buckets in front of the chairs.

Choose two contestants and have them stand on the chairs. Give each contestant a bag, and start the clock. Contestants have 60 seconds to drop as many candies into their bucket as possible. The contestant who gets the most candy into his bucket wins.

Variation:

Use a wider mouth bucket for smaller kids. You may also let them stand on the stage instead of up on chairs.

What's the Point?

This game takes focus. We can overcome fear, by keeping our focus on God.

PUMPKIN GUNK

Items needed:

Two opened pumpkins

Ten ping pong balls

Instructions:

Set five ping pong balls inside the each pumpkin.

Choose two players for this game. Set a pumpkin in front of each player. Players must reach into the pumpkins and pull out their five ping pong balls without looking inside. First one to get all five balls wins.

Variation:

Let smaller kids look inside, and cut the number of balls from 5 to 3.

What's the Point?

God has to clean us out so he can make is new. Let God scrape the gunk from your heart so he can complete his work in you!
